

InDesign Gutter Margin Preview

InDesign PDFs may display a sliver of the adjoining page in the gutter margin.

This may look odd in proofs, but files will print as built.

Settings can be modified to remove this feature.






Set up as Facing Pages in Document Setup

Left hand page is blank


Right hand page has a solid blue background

PDF Two Page Spread View - Default Settings



InDesign **Export > Marks and Bleed** settings for print may include **a sliver of the adjoining page** to indicate how the spread pages line up

Modified InDesign Export Bleed Settings



Modified settings maintain bleed on all outer margins
The gutter margin is now flush with final trim

To omit the gutter margin preview:

Under Export > Marks and Bleeds tab,

- Bleed settings must be unlinked and then
- Inside bleed margin set to zero
